Greetings,

After meeting with Mike and Kevin last week to fill in the blanks on the logistical questions raised at our last board meeting, I am submitting the attached proposal on their behalf.

They need a commitment from us ASAP because they need to turn in preliminary rosters by July 7th to reserve slots for the fall season.

Please keep in mind that this group has several other options for sponsorship, but they would really like to keep R.C. kids playing under the RARYS banner. So the question at hand for us is not if we'll allow them to play in MAYSA during the fall, but if we are willing to sponsor them. Please understand, if we choose not to sponsor them in the fall, that means they will not be registered with our club in the spring either (unless we would go through the gruesome process of player transfers again).

Please carefully read and consider the attached document and then let's decide if we need to pull together an in-person meeting or if we can put this to a board member vote over email.

## MAYSA Fall Option Proposal

We are proposing that RARYS would sponsor some teams in the MAYSA league during the fall 2016 season. The purpose is to provide an option for players seeking to develop their soccer skills in a more intensive environment and on a team that requires a higher level of commitment than the traditional RARYS fall model.

Following are the details of what specifically is being proposed as well as responses to some of the logistical questions posed by the RARYS board:

### Number of Teams

- One U12 Boys team (Coached by Kevin Whitney)
- One U12 Girls team (A coach has not yet been determined)
- One U14 Boys team (Coached by Mike Breiningner)
- One U14 Girls team (Coached by Julie Whitney)
- {Note "Boys" teams can be mixed boy and girls if needed}

### Roster Limits

- U12 = 14 player limit (8 V 8)
- U14 = 18 player limit (11 V 11)

### League Of Play

- Teams would be enrolled in the MAYSA Rec. B league
  - MAYSA has restructured their league from Classic and Rec. to Rec. A, B, & C.

### Team Formation

- MAYSA does not allow tryouts for players in their Rec. leagues. Rosters would be filled on a first come, first serve basis.

### Games

- Game Days = Saturdays and Sundays (Coaches have the latitude to try to rearrange and coordinate games to be played on Saturdays only)
- Number of Games = 8 {4 weekends}
- Season Length = Dependent on any rearranged games and tournament blackout dates
- Home Field = Proposal to allow U12 teams to play home games on the North Park field across Highway 14. U14 teams would play home games at Eagle School Field.
- Tournament Play – Options are available for tournament play during the fall season.

### Equipment

- Balls = Propose that RARYS would allow players to use RARYS equipment.
- Uniforms = Players would use same T-shirts that RARYS prints.

## Fees

- Player Fees = Proposed \$75 per player {U12 & U14}
- Fee Breakdown
  - MAYSA League Fees = \$37 per player
  - MAYSA Referee Fees (4 home games)
    - U12 = \$28 for Center, \$18 per A.R.
    - U14 = \$36 for Center, \$24 per A.R.
  - Field Fees = N/A
  - Jersey = Same as RARYS
  - WYSA Registration Fees = T.B.D.
  - Player Passes = No official player passes required.
- Tournament Fees – Additional fees would be collected if families decide to enroll in any tournaments.

## Referees

- MAYSA handles referee assignment.
  - Coaches would be responsible for handling any referee scheduling issues.
- Proposal that RARYS would provide coaches with checks to pay referees.

## Coaches

- Certification
  - No Coaching Certification required for previous MAYSA Rec. league.
  - The proposed head coaches all have or will have E level certification by the beginning of the season.
  - The potential assistant coaches all have Y level certification.
- Coach Passes
  - All head and assistant coaches have current coach passes.

## Registration

- Paper registration forms would be submitted to RARYS
- RARYS registrar would submit MAYSA Registration Worksheet.
  - Preliminary Registration Worksheet needs to be submitted by July 7<sup>th</sup> to guarantee team slots.
  - Final Alignment Meeting – July 13<sup>th</sup> {Kevin Whitney would attend and represent groups}
- Proposal that coaches would contact previous players and that RARYS would inform the community at large that they are adding a “MAYSA League Fall Option” to their program. Families who have already registered for the RARYS fall season would be given the opportunity to contact RARYS to indicate a desire to change leagues.

#### RARYS Liability Concerns

- The group understands and appreciates the willingness of the RARYS group to assume the inherent liability concerns of sponsoring additional coaches and teams in the MAYSA league.
- In the event of the need for disciplinary action, coaches and players will be expected to adhere to decisions made by the RARYS Board of Directors.

#### MAYSA Regulations

- Practice Length = Not more than 1.5 hours
- Practice Frequency = Recommended not more than 2-3 per week
- Play Time = 50% of game time
  - MAYSA does not have specific requirements that limit coaches from restricting play time due to discipline/behavior issues.

#### Evaluation Period

- It is understood that approval of the RARYS board to sponsor teams in the MAYSA fall league would be for the time period of one soccer calendar year (fall and spring seasons) with the intent to reevaluate continued sponsorship prior to the fall 2017 season.
